

# OUR GUARANTEES



## ***Our Promise to You***

- 1. We guarantee that our Great Pyrenees breeding stock are free of life threatening genetic disorders and have been tested for the following: Hip and elbow dysplasia, progressive retinal atrophy, and heart disease.*
- 2. We guarantee that our Great Pyrenees breeding stock have been provided with excellent daily care, including but not limited to, heartworm prevention, flea/tick prevention, quality dog food, nails trimmed, ears cleaned and coat brushed.*
- 3. We guarantee for 1 year against genetic defects or pre-existing conditions that inhibit normal activities. Hips are guaranteed against hip dysplasia for 2 years with OFA reading of Fair or better at 2 years of age. NOTE: Due to documented published adverse outcomes for early spay/neuters of large breed dogs, orthopedic warranty is void if dog is altered before 10 months of age.*
- 4. We guarantee for a period of 72 hours that the puppy is free of disease and is in good health. The Buyer is required to have the puppy vet checked within 3 days upon receiving the puppy in order to make this part of our guarantee valid.*
- 5. We guarantee that the puppy has been exposed to livestock (goats and chickens) between 4-8 weeks of age to start his preliminary livestock guardian training and start the development of its livestock guardian instincts.*
- 6. Though we do our best to only breed healthy dogs that have been tested clear for the above-mentioned genetic diseases, occasionally genetic problems may randomly occur. If this occurs during the warranty periods, we will either (at our discretion) refund up the original purchase price of the dog if said dog is returned and replaced with another dog, or pay vet expenses up to the original purchase price of the dog for only the above-mentioned conditions. We require the Buyer/Owner have all testing done on said dog and provide vet records showing proof of said defect for this warranty to be effective. We also reserve the right, at our*

*expense, to have the dog checked by a vet of our choice before offering a replacement puppy or refund.*

- 7. We do not provide a warranty against viral illness, improper bites or teeth issues, internal and external parasites, hernias, hypoglycemia, coccidiosis, giardia, or ingestion of foreign objects, chemicals, or physical injury once the puppy has left our premises.*
- 8. We retain the right to cancel these guarantees if the dog is not in good condition or appears to have been mistreated in any way.*

### **Your Promise to Us**

- 1. You agree to provide the dog with a loving and caring home and, to the best of your ability, keep the dog safe and ensure good health.*
- 2. You agree to place and keep a collar with identification tags listing your contact information on your dog at all times. It is also highly recommended that you microchip your dog as well.*
- 3. You agree not to allow the dog to get overweight or to unduly stress the puppy's developing body with excessive strenuous exercise in the first year of its life.*
- 4. You agree to discuss an appropriate vaccination and health checkup schedule with your veterinarian. If you choose not to vaccinate your puppy, that is your choice and responsibility; however, we will not be held liable or responsible in any way if one of our puppies contracts a communicable disease after leaving our home if this is not done.*
- 5. You agree not to breed the dog unless the following conditions are met: (a) dog is not bred before 2 years of age; (b) dog is vet checked and cleared of any genetic diseases including but not limited hip and elbow dysplasia, progressive retinal atrophy, and heart disease; (c) dog is bred only to a AKC fully registered pure bred Great Pyrenees dog that meets the same requirements listed above; (d) dog is not bred more than once every 12 months; and (e) parents and puppies are provided with the same care requirements as outlined in this guarantee.*

6. *You agree that if you do not intend to breed the dog, you will have the dog spayed or neutered no earlier than 10 months old, and no later than 14 months old.*
7. *You agree to have the dog on a diet that is approved by your veterinarian. Many health problems in dogs can be contributed to or caused by imbalanced or inadequate nutrition, or from being overfed. We highly recommend that you feed your puppy only Large Breed Formula Dog Food because large breed dogs have different nutrition requirements than other sized dogs.*
8. *You agree to contact the Seller immediately if you can no longer take care of the dog at any point during the dog's life. We will assist you in finding a suitable home for your dog.*
